Objective & Learning Outcome

Upon successful completion of this course the student will be able to:

- Identify the major hardware assemblies/subassemblies of the DRX-1 System and DRX-Mobile Kit.
- Demonstrate knowledge of DR System Console general information and system specifications.
- Operate the DR System Console to facilitate troubleshooting.
- Locate and Identify DR System Console components including spare parts ordering and parts ID.
- Perform adjustments and calibration to the DR System.
- Troubleshoot the DR System Console to the lowest replaceable unit.
- Analyze, evaluate, and troubleshoot image quality.
- Perform DR console and DRX-1/DRX-Mobile Hardware installation and follow established procedures for documentation and record retention as required to meet FDA and service requirements.

Training program Content

Training is performed by a Carestream Health Technical Trainer or Product Specialists in a designated Carestream Health training area with equipment supplied by Carestream Health. The course is structured with theoretical sessions integrated with practical hands on exercises.

This will include installation, maintenance, and qualification procedures.

1. Introduction to the DR system console, the hardware and software components
2. Software menus and operation
3. The digital image receptor and its operation
4. Installation of the DRX-1 system
5. Installation of the DRX-Mobile system
6. Calibration and checkout of the Detector
7. Installation and testing of the wireless device
8. Installation of the tether
9. EMI noise testing
10. System acceptance and compliance testing

Prerequisites

Before attending, the participant should have the following prerequisites:

Must have

- Fundamentals of x-ray imaging course (for example, DITEC Level 1) or equivalent x-ray background
- Basic electronics training
- Basic understanding of the use of Windows and the laptop.

Highly recommended

- An Understanding of Networking Concepts and Basic Network Troubleshooting
